Selection Process

Steers:

Selection Date: May 22nd @ 8am

Location: South Agriculture Facility

Students arrive on site and check in with the agricultural science teacher (AST). ASTs and the breeder will speak to the students about the animals. Students will be dismissed to view the animals for 30 minutes. As students exit the viewing area, they will draw their selection order number for their animal. If you cannot attend the selection date please let your AST or 4H leader know immediately. In an event a student cannot attend, an animal will be selected for the student. Exhibitors purchasing more than one animal will select their second animal after all exhibitors have selected one. If there is more than one student they will draw for their second animal. After all animals are selected, the trailers will be loaded in the following order: breeder, chapter, personal.

Turkeys:

Selection Date: September 20th @ 4pm

Location: Humble High School Agriculture Department

Turkeys will be divided into individual pens prior to the student's arrival. Students will collect their pen, verify wing band numbers and check out with an agricultural science teacher (AST). If you cannot attend the selection date please let your AST or 4H leader know immediately. In the event a student cannot attend, a designated person is responsible for picking up the pen before 5pm. Birds will be sold as is and not selected or exchanged for other birds.

Swine:

Selection Date: September 27th @ 4pm

Location: Kingwood Agriculture Science Facility

Students arrive and sit in the stands. Agricultural science teacher (AST) and breeders will speak to the students about the animals. Students will be dismissed to view the animals for 30 minutes. As students exit the viewing area, they will draw their selection order number for their animal and return to the stands. If you cannot attend the selection date please let your AST or 4H leader know immediately. In an event a student cannot attend, an animal will be selected for the student. Exhibitors purchasing more than one animal will select their second animal after all exhibitors have selected one. If there is more than one student they will draw for their second animal. After all animals are selected, the trailers will be loaded in the following order: breeder, chapter, personal.

Goats:

Selection Date: September 28th @ 4pm

Location: South Agriculture Science Facility

Exhibitors purchasing more than one pen will select their second pen after all exhibitors have selected one. If there is more than one student they will draw for their second pen.

Broilers:**Selection Date: December 11th @ 4pm****Location: Humble High School Agriculture Department**

Broilers will be divided into individual pens prior to the student's arrival. Students will collect their pen, verify wing band numbers and check out with an agricultural science teacher (AST). If you cannot attend the selection date please let your AST or 4H leader know immediately. In the event a student cannot attend, a designated person is responsible for picking up the pen before 5pm. Birds will be sold as is and not selected or exchanged for other birds.
